PARISH MEMBERSHIP:

We welcome all new parishioners to our parish family. Every family participating regularly in the spiritual life of our parish is encouraged to register at the Parish Office. Please inform us if you are moving.

BAPTISM:

It is mandatory to attend a baptism instruction class before scheduling the date for the baptism. Baptism is usually celebrated on the third Sunday of each month at 1:00 p.m. Parents must be registered parishioners and must attend pre-Baptism instruction usually given on the first Sunday of every month at 1:00 p.m. in the Gathering Room. Godparents must be practicing Catholics in good standing. Pre-registration at the Parish Office is necessary prior to the Baptism instruction.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Saturdays 11:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Other times by appointment. Communal Penance Services are celebrated seasonally.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK:

Please notify the Rectory of any elderly, shut-ins, or sick at home who wish to receive the Eucharist or Anointing of the Sick. Priests of the parish will be happy to visit parishioners in the hospitals in the area. Please notify the Parish Office if someone from your family is in the hospital and wishes a priest to visit.

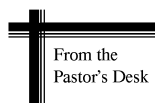

Readings for Sunday June 14, 2020

Dt 8:2-3, 14b-16a/Ps 147:12-13, 14-15,
19-20 [12]/1 Cor 10:16-17/Jn 6:51-58



Have you ever gotten up in the morning with a stiff neck? It's miserable—you have to walk like a robot, and even your shoulders and arms don't work right. Moses called the people "stiff-necked" because of their pride and arrogance. They weren't looking to right or left, just at their own desires. Moses cannot lead them to God if they only do what pleases THEM.

That greater perspective is at the very heart of our calling. Today is the **Feast of the Holy Trinity**. The word "Trinity" means that, when we were conceived, we were born into a community of holiness, the Trinity. We were "stamped" with that identity. Our God is One God—but that One God is the fullness of three Persons: the **Father** who created us, the **Son** who redeems us, and the **Holy Spirit** who comforts and inspires us.

Today we celebrate our life purpose, and our deepest calling—to call each other into unity with God, as the Persons of the Trinity are One. We are made in the image of a Unity, not just in the image of one of the Persons of the Trinity.

We experience that truth in those "peak moments" in life—those deep moments of harmony, feeling at one with everything—maybe similar to that moment when God looked at the creation and felt its goodness. Think of some rare, secret moment when you have felt such deep happiness that you knew in a flash that you were one with not just the world, but the whole universe. This is probably as close as we can experience in this life to who we really are in the fullness of the Divine Community.

Our church, **ekklesia** in Greek, means to be "called out" from aloneness, into that unity which only the Trinity models for us. Let's be busy encouraging everyone to feel this truth—even with masks and safe distancing!

✘ Next Sunday, June 14th, we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus**. Perhaps we remember this feast as **Corpus Christi**. Pope Francis has asked all of us to make the celebration of Corpus Christi truly special. We will live stream at 10am Mass after which we will expose the Blessed Sacrament for adoration and conclude with Benediction. Please, plan to join us for this beautiful day of Eucharistic Blessing for Ascension!

✘ The "Summer of 2020" is upon us. What will it be like? Unlike any we have known in the past in most respects. Instead of families and friends gathering for relaxing evenings in the park or a local restaurant, people will wear masks and stay apart from each other. Instead of work slowing down, it will require more effort in order to accomplish the work itself and comply with all the new safety regulations.

The elements of this summer that won't be different will be the cycle of nature that moves from cool evenings and lush green foliage these days in late May to the hot and dry weather of August. The other thing that won't change is God's absolute love for all creation and for each one of us. God will continue to send the Holy Spirit to guide us through whatever danger or difficulty we face and to unite us to His Son and to one another. For that is what he made us to be: not isolated and "distanced" but united and interconnected in Christ.

✘ I spoke with Fr. Hilary this week. He is in England and is awaiting the airports to re-open so he can return to Rome. He is well and sends his love to all. Fr. Hilary will not be with us this summer due to restrictions on immigration due to Kovid-19.

✘ Fr. Tim will be returning to help us with our weekend Masses when Phase 3 of Re-Opening begins. Let us be ready to give Fr. Tim a warm Ascension welcome back!

Know that I pray for you every day. Please pray for me, too. God Love You!

Directives for Re-Opening Churches

The guidelines below, given by Cardinal Tobin, apply to all churches and must be observed without exception.

1. Cardinal Tobin continues to dispense the faithful from the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday as well as from “Easter duty” (the obligation to receive Holy Communion during the season of Easter).
2. Churches may be opened solely for personal prayer during limited and designated hours. Individuals and families enter the church for quiet prayer only. During opening hours, a parish staff member must be physically present in the church to ensure social distancing and sanitizing. No gatherings are permitted.
3. In accord with national, state and local health directives, those who show symptoms of COVID-19 or who have been exposed to an infected person are not permitted to enter the church for 14 days.
4. Holy water fonts must remain empty until further notice.
5. Hand sanitizer should be made available throughout the church.
6. Public celebrations of liturgies, devotions, or other group prayer are not permitted at this time.
7. Masks must be worn by all individuals while in the church.
8. Individuals and families must maintain social distancing (six feet) between each person while in the church.
9. The pastor will ensure that there is prominent notification within the church regarding the requirement of masks and social distancing.
10. Pews, door handles and knobs, restrooms and high traffic areas of the church should be wiped down and sanitized at regular intervals with the removal of trash and other items from the pews.
11. The Sacrament of Reconciliation can be offered at specified and limited times.
 - a. Confessionals are not to be used.
 - b. Social distancing must be maintained by those waiting for the sacrament and attention be given to maintaining the seal.
 - c. Masks must be worn by confessor and penitent.

In addition, here at Ascension until further notice these additional directives must be followed for your safety:

- Church will be open from 12 noon to 3:00pm daily
- Enter side door near rectory
- All visitors, including children, must wear masks, have and use their own hand sanitizer and wipes.
- Practice social distancing (6 feet apart). We have roped off pews not to be used.
- You may light candles, please refrain from touching other areas in church.
- Holy Water will not be accessible
- Children must remain with adults at all times
- Bathrooms will not be open
- Please** No gathering or socializing in church

Confessions, please call the parish office, 201-836-8961, to make an appointment.
