BAPTISM:

It is mandatory to attend a baptism instruction class before scheduling the date for the baptism. Baptism is usually celebrated on the third Sunday of each month at 1:00 p.m. Parents must be registered parishioners and must attend pre-Baptism instruction usually given on the first Sunday of every month at 1:00 p.m. in the Gathering Room. Godparents must be practicing Catholics in good standing. Pre-registration at the Parish Office is necessary prior to the Baptism instruction.



Readings for Sunday November 22, 2020

Ez 34:11-12, 15-17/Ps 23:1-2, 2-3, 5-6 [1]/ 1 Cor 15:20-26, 28/Mt 25:31-46



There is a popular picture out there of an old sailing ship with the saying underneath, "A ship in the harbor is safe—but that is not what ships are built for." A boat's true calling is not a passive one! Of course, there are risks; but most sailors take the risks because the pay-off of making the effort is huge: to feel fully alive!

Today's gospel of the lazy servant who didn't invest the Master's money makes people squirm. Here I'm doing my best to keep what's been given to me safe and sound, and the angry Master says, "Why didn't you invest it?" Wow—can't I please anybody?

The Master is really attacking the common trap of fearing to risk. God gives us gifts, but we call them "ours"—and we start protecting "our" things...from "our" toys, to "our" house, to "our" kids. We build a life and get settled, and we soon quit taking our ship out of safe harbor. But—and this is a hard saying these days—the gifts God has given us belong to the world.

One family of 10 ran a small store. But they were never so focused on their own family that they didn't notice and help other poor families with free food or extended credit when needed. Another family limited sports so they could work at the homeless shelter one night a week. The daughter helped cook, the son sat and talked to the homeless men. These families remained conscious and alert to the state of the world around them—they took their ships out of harbor to help strangers. What a life lesson!

From age 9 to 90, we have to ask the hard question, "Am I in a comfortable rut?" Look around to see if the grieving, the poor, the lonely or homeless need us—because we need them to help us go beyond security, into the open seas of love. "A ship in the harbor is safe—but that is not what ships are built for."

UP-DATED Directives for Parish Liturgical Celebrations during the Covid 19 Pandemic

The guidelines below, given by Cardinal Tobin, apply to all churches and must be observed without exception.

- 1. Cardinal Tobin continues to dispense the faithful from the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday & Holy Days.
- 2. In accord with national, state and local health directives, those who show symptoms of COVID-19, who have been exposed to an infected person, or have traveled to unsafe places listed on the CDC.gov website, are not permitted to enter the church for 14 days. *It is recommended that before Mass, everyone should check their temperature at home before coming to Church.*
 - Those who are at risk because of an underlying health issue are strongly encouraged to avoide the risks posed by attendance at public celebrations of the Mass
- 3. Masks must be worn by all individuals while in the church.
- 4. Individuals must maintain social distancing (six feet) between each person while in the church.
- 5. A household may be seated together and not observe social distancing.

A household is defined as those people who have been living together under the same roof in close proximity throughout the quarantine. It does not include relative from other addressed or other extended family.

Note: There still will be a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass. Even with best health practices and strict social distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the coronavirus.

In addition, here at Ascension until further notice, these additional directives must be followed for your safety:

Daily Mass and Week-End Mass Schedule and directives are as follows

• Reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis.

You may reserve for daily & Sunday Mass for multiple weeks

- One Mass will be celebrated at <u>8:30am</u> in the Church (Monday-Friday). Our daily Mass will continue to be Livestreamed via Facebook.
- Saturday morning Mass will be celebrated & Livestreamed at 8:30am in the Church.
- Saturday Evening Mass will be celebrated in the Church at 5:30pm and on Sunday at 7:30am, 9:30am and 11:30am. Only the 5:30pm Mass will be Livestreamed via Facebook.
 - Attendance will be taken and no one will be admitted after Mass begins (doors will be locked). There is a limited capacity of 80 people.

All Funerals, Weddings, and Baptisms will follow the same protocol. (80 person capacity)

- -Enter side door near rectory
- -All visitors, including children, must wear masks, have and use their own hand sanitizer and wipes.

Please wipe down area you have used and take with you any items you use.

- -Practice social distancing (6 feet apart). We have roped off pews not to be used.
- -You may light candles, please refrain from touching other areas in church.
- -Children must remain with adults at all times
- -Bathrooms will not be open
- -Please No gathering or socializing in church or on church property


